SUBDIVISION: El Mirador Townhouses (1-41)

AMENITIES:

- Pool/Spa/Ramada Pool/Spa hours are 7am to 10 pm with quiet zone 7 am 9am.
 - All children under the age of 14 must be supervised by an adult.
 - Residents must accompany their quests at all times.
 - The pool is unheated.
- The Overlook is a multi-use area, east of the pool, overlooking the City. It is used for group gatherings or quiet contemplation.
- The Horseshoe Pit is located on the southwest corner of the community. This is another multi-use area for group entertainment or private contemplation. Seating provides beautiful Arizona sunset watching.

DUES AND OTHER

Dues through December, 2022 - \$177.50 per month

ASSESSMENTS:

Water Assessment - \$66.67 per month (Effective January 1 through December 31, 2022)

Succeeding year's assessment subject to actual water costs)

DUES INCLUDE:

Private Roads & Driveway Maintenance; Exterior Paint as implemented per Master Maintenance Schedule; Common Area Landscaping & Lighting (including front yards); All Water and Sewer costs (including individual homes); Upkeep of Pool, Spa, Ramada, Overlook,

and Horseshoe Pit; Trash Pick-up, Annual bulk pick-up.

PARKING

No Street parking (Please insure your vehicles fit into the garage and that there is sufficient

parking for the number of your vehicles - including suitable driveway parking).

Guest Parking is provided throughout the community for guests, who may park free for up to

7 days when Resident-Host makes arrangements with HOA.

Longer term "assigned" guest parking is available through the HOA at \$50 per month for either Resident or Guest use. A reserved space will be assigned. Illegally parked vehicles are

subject to fines and towing.

Garage doors are to be kept closed unless resident present & working inside. Our roads cannot accommodate large trucks. Large moving vans must either "off-load" to a small truck,

or "hand-dolly" items up into the community.
